Dear Friends,

Stasi and I were up in Spokane visiting our son last week; he wanted to show us some of his favorite places. We were on a hike down by the Little Spokane river when with a smile and a twinkle in his eye he said, "Now I want to show you a secret little waterfall." Cutting through a meadow, ducking behind some bushes, he brought us into a tiny glade where mint and wildflowers grew, and a delicate little cascade was rushing down the rocks into a sparkling pool. It was enchanting, and renewing, and so...life-giving. Big smile on his face as we all enjoyed his discovery.

Don't you love doing that – sharing something wonderful you have discovered? Especially if it is beautiful, and life-giving? I love showing people some of my secret places, or turning them on to new worship, or a great book, or a movie we love, or one of our favorite lakes. Sharing life is such a joy, and I love watching the expression on their faces when they experience the joy, too.

It reminds me of this scene from the gospel of John...

The next day John was back at his post with two disciples, who were watching. He looked up, saw Jesus walking nearby, and said, "Here he is, God's Passover Lamb." The two disciples heard him and went after Jesus. Jesus looked over his shoulder and said to them, "What are you after?" They said, "Rabbi" (which means "Teacher"), "where are you staying?" He replied, "Come along and see for yourself." They came, saw where he was living, and ended up staying with him for the day. It was late afternoon when this happened. Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard John's witness and followed Jesus. The first thing he did after finding where Jesus lived was find his own brother, Simon, telling him, "We've found the Messiah" (that is, "Christ"). He immediately led him to Jesus. (1:36-42 The Message)

I love it! I love Andrew's excitement: "You gotta see this!"
